Key responsibilities

In your role you will be an essential member of the ProTech Facility and involved in all aspects of recombinant protein production with a focus on protein purification. Specifically, your primary tasks will include:

- Test scale protein expression and purification,
- Multi-step chromatographic purification.

Key requirements

- Expertise in biochemistry, molecular biology, or a closely related field,
- Thorough understanding of the theoretical and technical principles of protein expression and purification,
- Demonstrable practical experience in protein purification and biochemistry,
- Experience with baculovirus mediated expression in insect cells is desirable,
- Self-organized and independent working style within a team,
- Excellent command of English (spoken and written) is required; German skills are an asset,
- Enthusiastic, friendly, collaborative mindset and the ability to interact professionally with our customers,
- Eagerness to adopt new technologies.
